### Year 2 Trip to Crosby Beach & Liverpool Philharmonic Hall

Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 2 will be having a fun trip to Liverpool on **Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> June 2025**. Children will need to be in school by **8.55am** as we want to leave school promptly at **9.30am**. We will be returning back to school in time for children to be collected at the end of the school day at **3.15pm**.

We will be visiting Crosby Beach in the morning to see the 'Another Place' statues by Antony Gormley. We will then move on to the Liverpool Philharmonic Hall in the afternoon for a Schools Concerts performance of 'We're going on a bear hunt'.

We are asking that children bring a spare pair of shoes for the beach - either trainers, sandals or crocs, and a carrier bag to put them in to stop sand coming back on to the coach.

Children will need a rucksack with them to carry their packed lunch. Everyone will need a packed lunch in a **named disposable bag** (not lunch boxes). A packed lunch can be brought from home or provided by the canteen. (Please indicate your preferences on ParentPay by answering **Y** or **N** to all questions). We will aim to recycle materials using the venue's facilities where possible. Please do not include sweets, fizzy drinks or money.

On **17<sup>th</sup> June**, children may wear trousers/jogging pants/leggings with their Farnborough sweatshirt and polo shirt. Children will also need a waterproof jacket and will need to wear sensible shoes or trainers depending on the weather.

The cost of the trip is **£15.00**, which includes **£5.00** entrance fee to the Liverpool Philharmonic Hall and the cost of the coach hire.

Our preferred method for payment is now ParentPay. Please sign up and give permission for your child to attend through ParentPay. If you experience any problems accessing your ParentPay account, please contact the office who will be happy to help you. Unfortunately, if we don't collect enough money, the visit may have to be cancelled.
