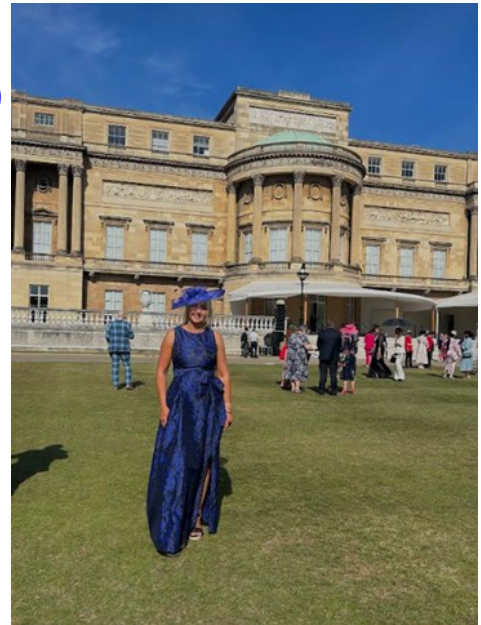
## A Royal Garden Party at Buckingham Palace
